# **NEW NATIONS Training Course**

A Training System for Personal, Community, and National Transformation

Welcome to the New Nations course sponsored by Vision of Community Fellowship (VOCF), Food for the Hungry International Federation (FHIF), and the Canaan Global Leadership Center.

#### Overview

New Nations is a book and training system based on the true story South Korea's rise from being one of the world's poorest countries during the 1950's to one of the most prosperous today. It follows the story of Kim Yong-ki and his family which helped inspire South Korea to begin the New Village Movement. A key theme throughout the course is to change a nation, we must first change our mindsets and lifestyles – not wait for outside assistance. While the New Nations book uses Canaan and Korea as a basis, the principles are cross-cultural and apply to any nation.

# Objectives

- To help you experience personal transformation with a new mindset and lifestyle.
- To establish a training system where small groups can learn and multiply the Canaan lifestyle.
- To begin a process of transformation in your community and nation.

# **Topics and Course Organization**

The standard course combines 12 chapters into 7 weeks of online study. Variations can be requested by groups: anywhere from 1 week, to 12 weeks, to go at your own speed. Participants typically need about 30-45 minutes to read each chapter and another 15-30 minutes to answer questions.
